Entry Card

All entries must be on an official entry card available at the Port Royal Landing Marina weigh-in station and mailed to the tournament headquarters promptly. No entries received after December 31 of current year will be considered. All entry cards must be completed in full. The tournament dates-- January 1 to December 31

Official Rules

- All fish entered must be caught on rod and reel from a boat in a sporting manner.
- Anglers must land fish without assistance except for gaffing and netting.
- Only fish larger (heavier) than those listed on the leader board may be weighed in.
- No mutilated or cut fish other than gaff marks (for instance) will be weighed.
- Decisions by weighmaster and/or

- tournament committee are final
- Participants must comply with all applicable Federal and State regulations
- Fish must be caught in South Carolina or Georgia saltwaters & weighed at PRLM.

Weigh Station

Anglers must present their own fish to the certified weighmaster at Port Royal Landing Marina for weighing during normal operating hours of 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. in winter and till 6 p.m. in spring and summer. They may arrive by boat or auto. The entry card must be completed in the presence of the angler and weighmaster and their signature confirms accuracy of the information. Awards

Anglers with the most winning species as of Dec. 31 will be awarded plaques in the following categories:

- Youth (anglers 16 years of age or under as of December 31 of current year.

- 10x10: Anglers 10 years of age or under compete for the largest of 10 species.
- Female Angler
- Overall Angler
- Overall awards for the Captains of the Recreational Boat and Charter Boat having the most winning species

Awards will be presented at the Beaufort Sportfishing and Diving Club during the Annual Oyster Roast held in January of following year.

Certificates - each category of 10x10, youth, female, and overall will be given a certificate for the largest species of each category.
